##### 1. Moving Integrated Data Forward, Johnson County, Iowa

*Clark Bernhardt introduced the presentation. Dane County is a member of the national—Data Driven Justice—in partnership with the organization leaders: NACO and Laura and John Arnold Foundation. Originally DDJ was an Obama Whitehouse initiative. Dane has been a member since 2017.*
