



Public Safety Assessment (PSA)

- As of 4/14/2023
 - 899 PSA were completed by Pretrial Services Assessors
 - 55 PSAs were not completed due to Bail Jumping Rule
 - 47 were not completed due to person having been in custody longer than three days
 - 8 were not completed due to extradition
- One of our two Pretrial Services Assessors transferred to another department on March 10, 2023. We are in process of hiring his replacement.
- Data on supervision is drawn from Automon case management software


Number of People Referred to Pretrial Supervision as of 4/17/2023



Cases opened in Q1 2023




Cases closed in Q1 2023




Advancing Pretrial Policy & Research (APPR)

APPR Senior Managers Dr. Kelvin Banks, Attorney Orleny Rojas, and Jessica Ireland provided training on the "Responsible Use of the Public Safety Assessment (PSA)."


This training on April 17, 2023, demonstrated why Dane County should transition away from its current Decision Making Framework (DMF) to a Release Conditions Matrix (RCM).

- Changes recommended:
 - Replace DMF with RCM and eliminate "bump-ups"
 - Avoid including recommendations of financial release conditions in matrix
 - Avoid using colors such as orange or red in any matrix
 - Update the Violent Offense List
 - Create Decision trees for in custody Initial Appearances and in custody Bail/Bond Hearings


Timeline for Transitioning to Release Conditions Matrix
